HIGHLIGHTS OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR CY 2005

OBJECTIVES:

- a) To confine and detain person safely as per commitment order issued by the court whether the subject has a case pending trial or convicted for not more than three (3) years.
- b) To provide rehabilitative program that will negate criminal tendencies and restore their positive values to make them productive and law abiding citizens.

STRENGTH:

- a) BDRC Personnel:

As of this date, we have ninety-seven (97) personnel compose of twenty six (26) organic regular employees and is augmented with sixty three (63) organic casual with eight (8) support staff from Governors Office and General Services Office.

- b) Inmate Population:

As of December 31, 2005 the BDRC inmate population is four hundred two (402), three hundred eighty nine (389) are male and thirteen (13) are female.

ACTIVITIES:

1. Guarding services:

For the year of 2005 we safely guarded the inmates while confined at BDRC compound, Cabawan District, Tagbilaran City.

2. Escorting services:

- a. We securely escorted 2,414 incidents of escorting services of inmates appearing trials as per court orders for the year 2005.
- b. For 2005 we had securely escorted 55 INSULAR PRISONERS being transferred to the Bureau of Correction, Muntinlupa City, Metro Manila.

- c. We also transferred 3 inmates for medical treatment to National Center for Mental Health, Muntinlupa City, Metro Manila.

3. Rehabilitation:

This center is undertaking rehabilitation activities in order to change the inmates pattern of criminal behavior and reform them into a law abiding and productive citizens through the implementation of rehabilitation programs in jail.

- a. Believing that true rehabilitation starts from the heart, Inmates must hear the good news of salvation through the living word of GOD. Different religious organizations are conducting spiritual activities inside the Bohol Detention Rehabilitation Center chapel.
- b. Sports and recreation in order to attend inmates physical fitness, they are encouraged to indulge in sports like basketball, volleyball and table tennis. Also music minded inmates is engaged into combo and have entertainment sessions in the afternoon.
- c. Livelihood projects:
 - 1. The inmates continue their piggery of six (6) heads and (10) ten piglets, poultry (broiler) with one hundred sixty (160) heads - 42 days old and one hundred thirty five (135) heads- 23 days old.
 - 2. The inmates are also engaged in the production of christmas lanterns and bottle decoration.
 - 3. Some are also involved in native placemat making.
- d. Backyard gardening

The inmates are also planting some vegetables and herbal plants that also augment their needs.

- e. Education and skills training

The Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School continue the conduct of project PAGLAUM, a project which provides skill training to twenty five (25) selected inmates, conducting classes every Saturday covering e subjects on Moral Values, Livestock and Vegetable Production, Screen printing and Culinary Arts.

OTHER ACTIVITIES:

- a. Regular Prison Cell inspection is conducted every Wednesday to ensure that no unauthorized materials or activity is going inside prison cells.

- b. Inspection to all visitors is intensified to ensure that no prohibited drugs or materials can enter the prison camp.
- c. Continue to conduct Troops Information, Education and Inspection of Personnel uniforms every 2nd Saturday of the month.
- d. Completion on the construction of drainage for stagnant water at the western portion of Bohol Detention & Rehabilitation Center compound.
- e. Completion on the construction of Top Guard Fence.
- f. Strict implementation on proper usage of electricity and water which resulted to a very minimal consumption.
- g. We strictly implement the proper usage of service vehicle and control the issuance of fuel and lubricants.
