I. HIGHLIGHTS OF 2005 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

(a) Plans -

- Computerization Program of the Bohol PNP

The Project is also known as Province-Municipal Police Information and Communication System (PMPICS) which was realized through the joint efforts of the Provincial Governor and the League of Municipalities. This was designed to improve the delivery of information and linking of communication system among PNP unit/stations including other government offices as well as non-government organizations. Furthermore, looking forward to increase workability and input of Police Basic services to carry out wholeheartedly its mandated task and mission. However, other Police Stations don't have any telephone lines for the Internet Line. The cost of the project is placed at two million two hundred (P2,200,000.00) pesos.

(b) Programs -

- Establishment of Police Environmental Desk Office (PEDO)

Pursuant to Letter of Instruction 10/01 (Perfect Environment) Police Environmental Desk Office (PEDO) was created and established down to the police stations level as adopted by NHQ PNP per NALECC Resolution No. 11-2002 and Letter of Instruction 08/03 (National Perfect Environment) dated 14, February 2003 and formally launched last 15 August 2003 for adoption nationwide.

The purpose of this, was to provide a prescribe and quick response mechanism to address threats relative to environmental and natural resources. Henceforth, Environment Desks were established in the Provincial Office down to the City/Municipal Police stations in the whole province, since we are gifted with diverse forest, coastal and marine resources.

- Establishment of Women /Children's Desk

In line with the program of the PNP to address the basic delivery of services on Women's and Children Cases, this office is now one hundred (100) percent filled-up of Women's and Children Desks in every Police Station province wide. This was designed to handle/monitor all cases involving women and children in their respective locality. Likewise, it aimed to conduct information drive relative to violations on child abuses and trafficking.

(c) Accomplishments -

- a. Operational
  - Campaign against Illegal Drugs

An aggressive police action has also been intensified to reduce the supply and demand of drugs. A total of seventy-seven (77) police operations against dangerous drugs were conducted. These operations resulted in the arrest of one hundred two (102) persons, the uprooting of one hundred four (104) stalks of MJ plants, one (1) MJ cigarette and one (1) cellophane pack MJ leaves, the confiscation of 516 packs/sachets of shabu and twelve (12) bottles and forty (40) packs of rugby with seventy four (74) cases were also filed in court. The over proceeds/marked money is P66,712.25.

- Campaign against Illegal Gambling

With the intensified efforts of the authorities in cooperation with the government and the populace, local number games locally known as MASIAO has gradually vanish. However other forms of illegal gambling are still existing in the countryside such as Suretres, Tigbakay, Hantak and Card games. For the period covered, this office has conducted 80 police operations resulting in the arrest of 166 persons and confiscation of voluminous computer tips, 12 units of MC, 72 fighting cocks, several playing cards with P13, 472.60 money bets. A total of 63 cases were filed in court against all persons arrested.

- Campaign against Illegal Possession of Firearms

In the implementation of "OPLAN PAGLALANSAG OMEGA" and "OPLAN KATAPAT SIETE" this office has successfully accounted at least fifteen (15) high-powered firearms and fifty five (55) low powered firearms or a total of 70 firearms. Out of this, 61 persons were arrested 59 cases were filed in court.

- Campaign against Illegal logging/Fishing

In line with "LOI KALIKASAN", this office has intensified the enforcement of environmental protection laws, which resulted in the arrest of 17 persons and the confiscation of 9,503.16 board feet of assorted lumbers, 65 pcs. abandoned mangroves and 63 pcs. square logs of Baganga tree with 23 operations against illegal logging/transporting of illegally cut forest products were made which led to the filing of 16 cases in court. This office also arrested 985 persons engaged in illegal fishing, 224 fishing boats, 1 bottle dynamite with blasting caps, 21 bags of potassium nitrate, 34 kilos of potassium nitrate, 5 bundles of blasting caps, one (1) container cyanide, 30 sacks of ammonium nitrate and confiscated some 3.5 million worth of fishing paraphernalia's in 279 operations conducted.

- Campaign against Wanted Person

On the implementation of OPLAN TRACKER, out of the 485 warrants/subpoena served 437 wanted persons were arrested posting a 90% accounting efficiency.

- Campaign against PD 533

On Cattle-Rustling, one (1) person was arrested and charged in court and recovered one (1) large cattle.

- Implementation of Internal Security Operations (ISO)

The PNP in our support rule to the AFP troops dedicated for Integral Security Operations/Counter Insurgency, two (2) PNP Mobile Groups are in the province, the 701<sup>st</sup> PMG located at Camp Dagohoy, Tagbilaran City and 4<sup>th</sup> RMG7 Coy located in Catagbacan , Loon, Bohol. Aside from the operations conducted by the Special Operation Team (SOT) of the AFP, monthly CIVACs are also being conducted initiated by the PPOC of the Bohol participated by the National and Provincial Gus particularly the PNP and AFP.

Due to the intensified implementation of SOT operations and CIVAC programs, the local government is now gaining grounds from the populace at the influenced and infiltrated barangays. Apparently, they are now convinced with the sincerity of the government program, hence, the neutralization of these areas is underway.

b. Prevention against Terrorism -

In order to re-echo the government Three-Tiered Defense System against terrorism, a conference was called at Hqs Bohol PPO last October 26, 2005 attended by the operation officers of various malls, resorts and restaurants, critical infrastructures, vital installations and economic key points in Bohol. Aforesaid conference was also aimed towards assessing, evaluating their respective security programs and contingency plans.

Likewise, a three (3) day Critical Incident Management Simulation Exercises seminar was held at Dumaluan Beach Resort, Panglao, Bohol. On August 3-5 2005, undertaken by Philippine Center on Transnational Crimes (PCTC), in coordination with our Office attended by some Provincial and Municipal Officials, Staff Officers and selected Chiefs of Police of Bohol PPO.

Bohol PPO has also provided and conducted security operations during the holding of Miss Earth Beauty Pageant in Bohol. Monthly CIVAC action, arrival of VIPs and Foreign dignitaries, 109<sup>th</sup> Birthday celebration of illustrious son of Bohol - the late President Carlos P. Garcia and the much attended boxing bout of Rey "Boom-Boom" Bautista at CPG Sports Complex last December 2005.

c. Administrative -

For the period covered, this office initiated/conducted twenty-two (22) various seminars and training's in the different field of instructions with a total of 1,427 personnel as beneficiary/participants. Furthermore, a total of 161 undergraduate personnel provincewide were likewise recipient of the Distant Education Program extended by the government.
