# COMPREHENSIVE PROJECT PROFILE

## I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. PROJECT TITLE: **Reducing Poverty through Improving Sanitation and Health (REDPISH) Project**
2. PROJECT TYPE: **Capital Forming and Technical Assistance**
3. PROJECT COMPONENTS

### 3.1. Social Preparation

To ensure participation and coordination of the community in the project proposed for implementation, barangay consultations will be conducted. Participatory action planning and consensus building will be called to obtain the Information campaigns on environmental conservation, proper waste management, pollution control and prevention of ozone depletion will be conducted. Billboards will be posted at strategic areas for the awareness of visitors. Resolutions relative to the operation of the project will be prepared, passed and will be made known to all constituents.

### 3.2. Distribution of Sanitary Toilet Bowls

One toilet bowl, one half (1/2) sheet of plywood, two (2) pieces of ten (10) mm Ø rebar, three (3) bags of cement and one fourth (¼) kilo of G.I. tie wire (for the floor slab) will be distributed to households for construction at their respective homes. Excavation of septic tank (1 M x 1M x 1.5 M), sand and gravel for the floor slab and walls for the comfort room will be shouldered by the individual households as counterpart.

### 3.3 Information campaigns

Information campaigns on sanitation will be conducted with additional inputs on environmental protection and rehabilitation. Housewives will be trained on how to segregate biodegradable with non-biodegradable wastes. Organic backyard farming will be promoted as well.

## 4. PROJECT LOCATION

The project is proposed for implementation in all twenty three (23) barangays of Pres. C.P. Garcia, Bohol.

## II. PROJECT STATUS

The sanitation support project is proposed for implementation.

## III. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

### 1. Project Background

Pres. Carlos P. Garcia is an island municipality located in the northeastern part of Bohol. It is a fifth class municipality composed of twenty three (23) barangays. Its total land area of 54.82 sq. km. is home to 20,744 inhabitants. This municipality belongs to the third congressional district of Bohol.

The 2004 Poverty Database Monitoring System ( PDMS) survey shows that 1,843 of the total households in the municipality have no access to sanitary human waste disposal facilities.

The project hopes to decrease the number of households who have no access to sanitary toilets and enable them to maintain a clean and sanitary surrounding. With this, there will be lesser cases of food contamination caused by flies and other airborne diseases.

### 2. PROJECT LINKAGES

The proposed project is in line with the poverty reduction initiatives of the provincial and municipal government. Need for technical assistance may be coordinated with health and social welfare offices of the provincial and municipal agencies like the municipal health office and the Department of Social Welfare and Development.

### 3. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

General.

To improve the living condition of the rural community by providing them sanitation facilities.

Specific:

1. To provide homes with toilet bowls and have sanitary toilets.
2. To promote and maintain cleanliness in the barangays and in the entire municipality.

### 4. SECTORAL OBJECTIVES

The project is in line with the poverty alleviation initiatives of the municipal local government. It aims to improve the lives of the local community by providing them materials for the installation of individual sanitary waste disposal facilities.

## 5. REGIONAL AND NATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The project, in general, promotes and upholds the attainment of the international Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) of the United Nations wherein the Philippines is among the signatories. It is contributory to the poverty reduction initiatives of the provincial government and local government unit.

## IV. PROJECT FINANCING

### 1. FUNDS NEEDED

A total of **THREE MILLION PESOS(Php 3,000,000.00)** is required for the implementation of the proposed project with breakdown as follows:

## V. PROJECT BENEFITS AND COSTS

### 1. BENEFICIARIES

The 1,843 households (2004 PDMS) will benefit from the project specifically the children and elderlies of the municipality

Indirect beneficiaries are the local and foreign guests, the BLGU and MLGU.

### 2. BENEFITS

Decrease in problem on sanitation will result to savings for families to enable them to have access to better health care, nutrition, housing and decrease in cases of child malnutrition and mortality as well as access to education, potable water and decrease of the occurrence of waterborne diseases.

### 3. COSTS

No social or economic cost is expected of the project.

## VI. PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

### 1. RESPONSIBLE AGENCIES

The Municipal Local Government Unit (MLGU) through its Municipal Health Office(MHO), Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) , Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO) and Municipal Engineer's Office in coordination with the Barangay Local Government Units. The organized community group however will take charge of monitoring its members' compliance to policies and guidelines on project management and sustainability.
