1. Project Title : Environmental Sanitation Program (Sanitary Program)  
This Project aims to provide the material for the construction of sanitary toilet to individual households without latrines within the 19 barangay's of Guindulman, Bohol

#### **III. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION**

1. Project Background:

As of December 2006, there are about 20% or 1,200 households still do not have their own sanitary toilet. The primary reason is inability to construct their own sanitary toilet is financial whatever money they earned is prioritized for their survival needs and other commodities. If there is no intervention extended to them, the households will continue to dispose their human wastes improperly & it can contaminate to our ground water sources.

It is the primary reason why our municipality has sporadic cases of gastrointestinal diseases like amoebiasis, diarrhea, hepatitis and intestinal parasitism.

This Project will complement with other projects like nutrition & poverty alleviation projects of the barangays.

  - a.) To motivate household beneficiaries to practice proper excreta disposal.
