- I. PROJECT TITLE : LAKATAN PRODUCTION
- II. PROPONENT : MLG-MAO

### **RATIONALE:**

Inabanga is an agricultural town located at the northern part of Bohol. It is blessed with good soil and agro climatic condition suitable for banana production. The adoption of improved technology on banana will lead the way for better banana industry. Bananas are not considered as basic food commodity, but they are important sources of minerals and vitamins.

Banana growing is profitable and requires technical know-how from planting, plant and fruit management, post harvest handling and marketing. The lack as well as inappropriate use of technology could spell its failure or success.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

To provide alternative sources of income for the marginal farmers who are members of registered People's Organization.

#### **Specific Objectives:**

1. To generate income and employment for the unskilled farmers.
2. To develop camaraderie between and among the farmers in the community.
3. To increase production of lakatan by 4% per year.
4. To uplift the standard of living among marginal farmers in the community.

### **PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION**

The Municipal Government of Inabanga will be responsible for the overall implementation of this project thru the Municipal Agriculture Office. Technical assistance will be provided by the staff of the Municipal Agriculture, although the farmer beneficiaries of the project will be responsible for the proper utilization and maintenance of lakatan production project.

Since it falls on the Roll-Over-Scheme type of project, it is mandated that after the mother plant produces suckers, the farmer beneficiary should give back at least two suckers to the Municipal Agriculture Office for the next line beneficiaries that could also avail of it. So, monitoring and evaluation should be handed by the staff of the Municipal Agriculturist to enhance sustainability of the project.
