## **COMPREHENSIVE PROJECT PROFILE**

### **1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

#### **1.1 PROJECT TITLE**

**Completion of Municipal Gymnasium**

#### **1.2 PROJECT TYPE**

The project is Capital Forming

#### **1.3 PROJECT COMPONENTS**

The project is on its completion stage.

#### **1.4 PROJECT LOCATION**

The project is located at Poblacion, Sevilla, Bohol.

### **2. PROJECT STATUS**

The project was already started 4 years ago. The fund that was used to start the project came from the Provincial Government. The project proposal is intended to solicit funds for its completion.

### **3. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION**

#### **3.1 PROJECT BACKGROUND**

The municipality of Sevilla, Bohol is among the towns which was created during the Spanish regime way back in July 7, 1870 by virtue of the decree issued by a Spanish Governor General Carlos M. de la Torre. Since then, the town was not able to construct a municipal gymnasium which is very necessary in the conduct of huge functions particularly a community gathering. In previous community gatherings and assemblies we are only using a Municipal stage wherein the crowd is subjected to the force of nature – the heat of the sun during sunny season and the rain during rainy season.

In order to solve the aforementioned problem we are constructing a municipal gymnasium which will be an all weather venue of huge gatherings of our constituents.

### **3.2 PROJECT LINKAGES**

The said project is in conformity with our approved Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP), Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) and Annual Investment Program (AIP). It compliments other projects of the town focusing general services.

### **3.3 PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

The main objective of the project is to provide an all weather venue of public gatherings such as general assemblies and the like. The aforesaid structure will likewise be used as a venue for sports activities particularly for the youth.

### **3.4 SECTORAL OBJECTIVES**

- 3.4.1 To construct better general services facility.
- 3.4.2 To provide better venue for sports and recreation.
- 3.4.3 To encourage the youth to engage in regular sports activities by providing an excellent venue for sports competition.

### **3.5 REGIONAL AND NATIONAL OBJECTIVES**

This project is in line with the Regional and National Thrusts of providing better service facility to every Filipino.

## **4. PROJECT FINANCING**

4.1 The funds needed to complete the project is THREE MILLION PESOS (p 3,000,000.00) broken down as follows:

## **4.2 PROJECT FINANCING**

If the funds for the project is already available, the mode of implementation will be by administration in order to maximize the funds. A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) will be proposed for the purpose.

## **4.3 FUNDING SOURCE**

Funds for the purpose will be sourced out from PDAF of Congressman and Senators and from foreign donors.

## **4.4 COUNTERPART FUNDING**

As much as possible, counter parting scheme of project implementation will be observed. The Provincial Government had already counter parted P 3,000,000.00 and the local government unit handled the site development as its project counterpart.

# **5. PROJECT BENEFIT AND COSTS**

## **5.1 BENEFICIARIES**

The proposed project beneficiary will be the whole town of Sevilla, Bohol with an approximate population of 12,000. The project would also benefit the senior citizen, women and youth sector as a venue of the yearly gatherings of their association.

## **5.2 SOCIAL BENEFITS**

The proposed project when realized will then be a venue of all public and private gatherings. Moreover, the proposed project is constructed in an institutional zone where projects such as this must be located. The aforesaid project will also contribute to the beautification thrusts of the town.

## **5.3 ECONOMIC BENEFITS**

The realization of the aforesaid project would surely benefit the economic aspect of the local government unit. Because of the absence of a municipal gymnasium, the LGU would spend much in fencing the area in the conduct of any activity requiring paid entrance. On the contrary, the LGU can raise revenue thru this project by requiring fees to private individuals who wants to use the building for private functions.

## **5.4 SOCIAL COSTS**

There is no social cost associated in proposed construction of a Municipal Gymnasium.

## **5.5 ECONOMIC COSTS**

The proposed construction of a Municipal Gymnasium has no problem to our local economy. Instead, a project such as this would be very beneficial to our constituents by affording them better delivery of services.

## **6. PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION**

### **6.1 RESPONSIBLE AGENCIES**

### **6.2 IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE**

The aforesaid project is one of the priority project of the town. Once funding is already available, the schedule of implementation will be furnished immediately to the funding donors/agencies before the start of the project.

### **6.3 LEGAL AND POLITICAL FEASIBILITY**

The project has no legal and political problem. In fact, the project has already been started. This project proposal is prepared for completion purposes.

### **6.4 ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE**
