



Fast track service for motorway presentations

Speed was of the essence when initial discussions took place between design group, The Church Agency, and Access Displays Limited, on 6 May 2008.

A lightweight, portable, easy to assemble and flexible system was required to display up to 22, fine detail graphics, each measuring 1136mm x 836mm.

The displays were needed for the ongoing local presentation programme of the new M4 Junction11 improvement scheme – a £65million project involving The Highways Agency, multi services consultancy PBA, Laing and the Dept. for Transport.

A Plex modular panel system was recommended together with high quality light jet printed graphics. Artwork was finalised and proofed on 13th May and printing completed on 14th May. Special courier delivered graphics and stand hardware, directly to the client on 15th May, to complete the job.
