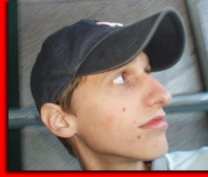

NEWS OF THE NIGHT

“Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. I am so thankful when I think back on who I used to be and what I used to do and then consider where He has taken me. He gives hope where there was no hope. He gives purpose where there was no purpose. He has blessed us all so abundantly!

This month, I started working with the Media Department about 10 hours a week. Most of that time, I am training the Media Apprentices to run sound. The Media Apprentices get on-the-job training with video and audio work. The Global Prayer Room is broadcast 24/7 on our web stream with an audience of at least 3,000 people at any given time. And about 8-10 hours a day, we are broadcast in many different places throughout world on GOD TV. My responsibility is to work with about 4 Media Apprentices individually on a weekly basis and train them to mix sound. It is a great opportunity to not only to work on my skills in sound but also to hone my teaching abilities. I am having so much fun but it is also tiring. As you can see down in the “Prayer Points” section, physical strength is one request that I have. Thank you so much for partnering with me!

WHAT GOD IS TEACHING ME

I love Psalm 119 because it sings the praises of the Word of God, which is the primary way that God reveals Himself to us. I don't think that it's a coincidence that it is the longest chapter in the Bible. This month, all I am going to do for this section is list some of my favorite verses from this chapter on which I have been meditating.

- *With my whole heart I have sought You; Oh, let me not wander from Your commandments!* (vs. 10)
- *Open my eyes, that I may see wondrous things from Your law. I am a stranger in the earth; Do not hide Your commandments from me.* (18-19)
- *Turn away my eyes from looking at worthless things, and revive me in Your way.* (37)
- *And I will delight myself in Your commandments, which I love.* (47)
- *The law of Your mouth is better to me than thousands of coins of gold and silver.* (72)
- *Unless Your law had been my delight, I would then have perished in my affliction.* (92)
- *Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.* (105)
- *My flesh trembles for fear of You, and I am afraid of Your judgments.* (120)
- *The entrance of Your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple.* (130)
- *I opened my mouth and panted, for I longed for Your commandments.* (131)
- *Rivers of water run down from my eyes, because men do not keep Your law.* (136)
- *The entirety of Your word is truth, and every one of Your righteous judgments endures forever.* (160)

On September 19, 1999, a prayer meeting began which continues to this day.
