WHAT GOD IS TEACHING ME

One of the values we have at IHOP is praying biblical prayer. We pray according to what God has already promised in Scripture. Some of the main examples of prayer in the Bible are the *apostolic prayers*, prayers offered up by the apostles in their epistles. Some examples of apostolic prayers are: Eph. 1:17-19, Eph. 3:16-19, Phil. 1:9-11, Col. 1:9-11 & Acts 4:29-31.

Following are some of the reasons why it is good to pray the apostolic prayers:

1. They are positive and God-centered. It gets the focus off of the problem and off of the Enemy and on to the Solution, the All-powerful Father.
2. They are focused on the Church. If the Church gets set on fire for God, everything else falls in to place. The lost are saved, injustices are made right and hearts and encouraged.
3. They are focused on a specific city or region. It is much easier to pray a prayer in faith when we can visualize what the answer to that prayer would look like. We can picture a city getting touched by the power of God and experiencing revival much easier than picturing every single youth in the entire world being touched.
4. They are already inspired by God. Since they are in inspired Scripture, they already have God's "stamp of approval." We can pray in full assurance that they will be answered.

These are just some of the many reasons to pray the apostolic prayers. I have been so encouraged to intercede when I pray according to the Bible.

WHAT IS IHOP ALL ABOUT?

On September 19, 1999, a prayer meeting began which continues to this day. From dawn to dusk and through the watches of the night, prayer and worship continues twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. The Prayer Room is the heartbeat – the essence and origin – of all that goes on at the International House of Prayer. May the fire on the altar never go out.



The Global Prayer Room is the central location for the missions base. It was designed to reflect the tabernacle of David (1 Chronicles 22–24), where worship and intercession never cease. The prayer room itself is a large room arranged with chairs and tables, which is open to the public 24/7, day and night. Here we worship our Savior and intercede for our world.
